Training Platform - Impact & Results

- Tested by 50+ SMEs across Europe, the online course achieved an average satisfaction rating above 4.3/5.
- Over **90% of users** confirmed that the training will help their businesses operate more sustainably with AI.
- The curriculum, aligned with **DigComp** and **GreenComp**, provides **10 modules**, case studies, and interactive resources.


Micro-Credentials & Certification

- Learners earn digital badges for each module and a final Europass-compatible certificate, ensuring recognition of their new competences.

- A long-term roadmap (2025–2027) ensures sustainability and network expansion.
